The Prospective Contract contains the Schedule of Supplies and Services (Part I), Contract Special Provisions (Part II), Contract General Provisions (Part III), as well as the Statement of Work (Part IV) and the Annexes thereto set forth detailed specifications governing the performance requirements of the Contract.


